Last Friday the high school students gathered at Coronado Dog Beach for vespers and fellowship.










































































Welcome Cesar Segura, VP of Finance interview conducted by Gloria Dong and Katheryn Lopez, 10th grade Publications students


7th and 8th Grade Welcome Back Activity at the Park
